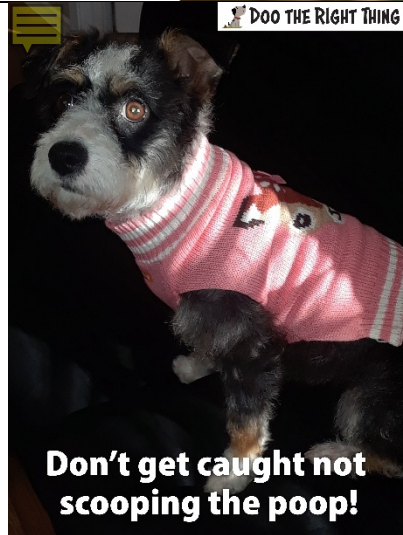
DOO THE RIGHT THING
