


- The <u>draft FY2022 Work Program</u> is available on the WATER committee webpage and was distributed in the meeting reminder



#### Proper Usage of Home Cleaning Products Draft Video Script

Home cleaning products such as glass cleaner, bleach, liquid plumber, and more should always be used carefully and in accordance with the instructions on the container. Improper use of these items can be dangerous to your health and cause damage to the pipes in your home.

Never pour these products down the drain because mixing them can cause reactions that release toxic gases or generate extreme heat. Additionally, these chemicals can cause damage to wastewater treatment systems, can be dangerous for employees, and negatively impact water quality and wildlife.

If you need to dispose of any cleaning products, check with your city to see what is accepted in your trash or be sure to take them to a household hazardous waste collection center. Remember, never pour these items down the drain!
