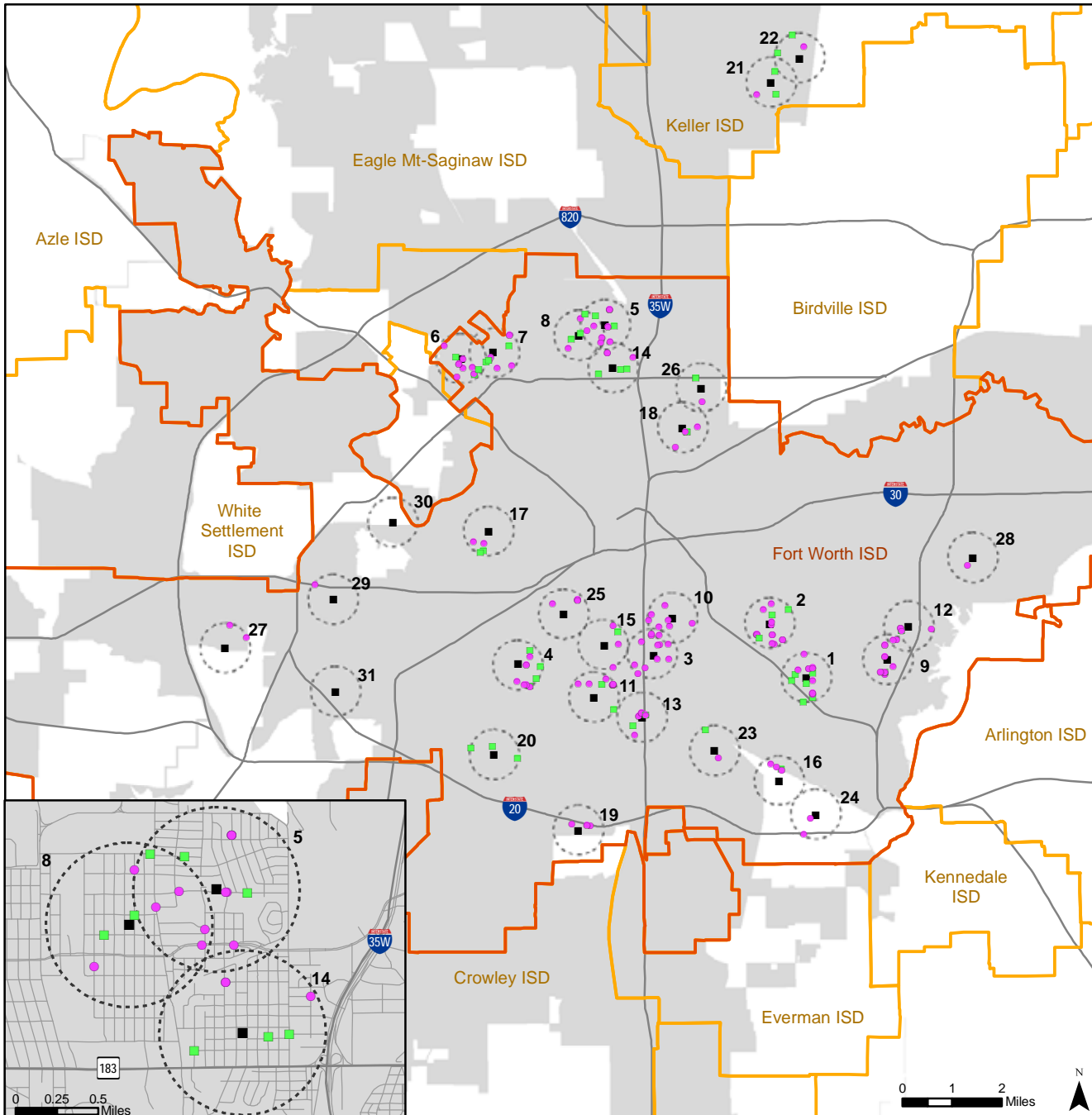


Bicycle and Pedestrian Crashes Around Blue Zones-Target Schools: 2009-2013 TxDOT Data

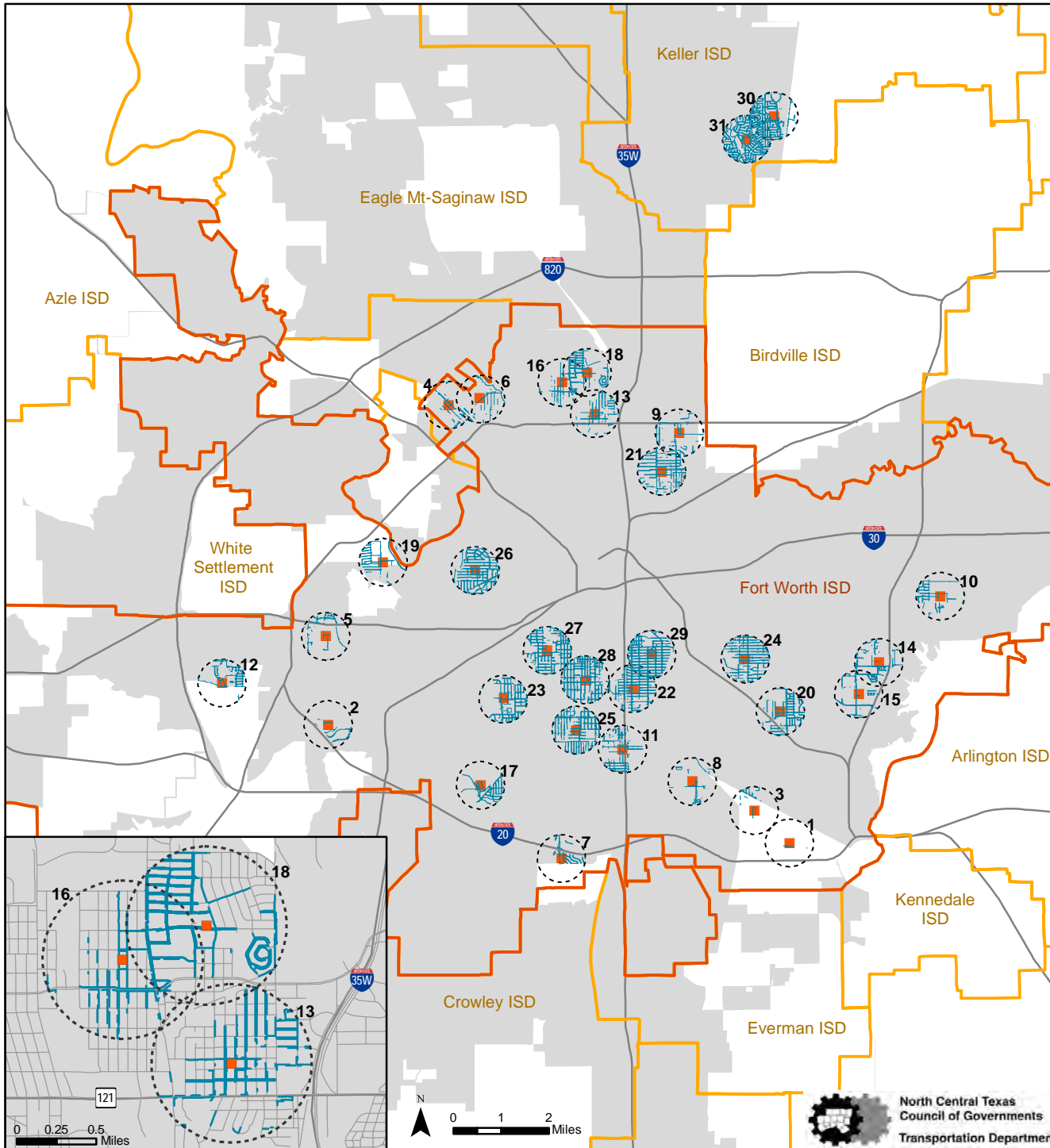
