 - **a. Basic Dry Weather Field Screening Training.** NCTCOG staff will update the Task Force on plans for the June 27th Basic DWFS Training.

Mia Brown informed the Task Force that the Basic DWFS training would take place on June 27th, 2018, at the Carrollton Public Library – Josey Ranch Lake, and that staff from the City of Arlington would lead the training. Registration will open in May.

b. Industrial Inspectors Workshop. NCTCOG staff will update the Task Force on details for the April 6th Municipal Industrial Inspectors Workshop.

Mia Brown gave the Task Force the details for the April 6th, 2018, Industrial Inspectors Workshop, including the final agenda, and that two spots remained for the training. Details for registered attendees would be sent via email at the end of the week.

c. IDDE Field Investigation Guide. NCTCOG staff will review the IDDE Field Investigation Guide with the Task Force with its first round of comments incorporated and take any final comments.

The City of Hurst responded to a discharge of 32 industrial totes at a paint facility.

The City of Lewisville is investigating an illicit discharge from an outfall near a middle school that occurs intermittently.

The City of Fort Worth received their permit filing and will also be starting their dry weather field screening program soon.
