1. Summary from last meeting

The meeting summary from the April 3, 2014 meeting was accepted as written.

2. Contact clearing house demonstration

The online IDDE contact clearing house was shown. The web page is tied directly to one of NCTCOG's SQL servers and is updated and backed up automatically. The page is not 'findable' with search engines and will remain unlinked to any other web pages. The link will be emailed to task force members with the meeting summary. Requested changes include adding a comments section, being able to download to a PDF, and adding contacts from TxDOT, TRA, NTMWD, and UTRWD. Contacts from nonparticipants in the Regional Stormwater Program are still pending and assistance was requested from neighboring MS4s to help gather that information.


5. Industrial Inspector Workshop update


